



## SPY VALLEY RIESLING 2019

Region	Marlborough, New Zealand	
Vineyards	Single Vineyard. Waihopai Valley - alluvial stony silt loam, very well drained.	
Viticulture	Viticulturist - Adam McCone Vertical shoot positioning with shoot and bunch thinning to restrict yield.	
Winemakers	Wendy Stuckey and Emily Gaspard-Clark	
Winemaking	Fruit was harvested from our 3 Riesling Blocks on the Waihopai Valley site over a period of 3 weeks. Harvested at peak ripeness, tank fermented and matured for 3 years prior to bottling in May 2022.	
Vintage	2019 was a very dry and warm growing season bringing with it small yields with great fruit concentration. One of our earliest harvests with picking starting at the beginning of March and completed by early April.	
Technical	Pick dates:	14 - 28 March 2019
	Brix	22 - 22.5 Brix
	Alcohol	12.5%
	Acid	pH 3.04 TA 6.0 g/l
	Residual Sugar	1.5g/L
Aroma	Lifted lime, honeysuckle and river stone.	
Palate	This wine has several years of age and so is now showing beautiful aromatics of an older Riesling.	
Cellaring	The powerful structure of this wine should see it continue to age gracefully for many years to come - enjoy the ageing process of one of the stand out varieties at Spy Valley.
