Murray-Darling Australia

Bold and crimson in colour. Lifted blackcurrant & blueberry aromas coupled with subtle savoury hints of black olive, tomato leaf, fresh rosemary. All carried onto the medium bodied palate. A well-structured wine with oak nuances and balanced integrated tannins signifying the variety. Fruit sweetness and fresh acidity drives the lengthy finish Drinking well now. Alcohol volume 13.5%, pH 3.54, Acidity 6.2 g/L.

Winemaker: Shane Kerr

Grapes are monitored on the vine for sugar level and tasted for seed ripeness. Once harvested they're put straight to ferment for daily remontage and tasting. This ensures the tannins and fruit flavours are balanced and the anthocyanins are concentrated, pronouncing colour. Oak maturation and blending follows before bottling in our sustainable packaging.

Best consumed at 14°C to accompany grilled lamb cutlets on a bed of seasonal veg.
